

Report of a birding trip to Ghana from 22 April to 8 May 2011

Introduction

We (Dick Brilstra, Eldert Groenewoud, Peter Los, Peter van Scheepen and Dick Meijer) decided to bird Ghana, our main objective being to see as many of the West African or more appropriate of the Upper Guinea forest endemics and near-endemics as possible, with Yellow-headed Picathartes at the top of our list. Having said so one has to point out what exactly an Upper Guinea endemic is. Nik Borrow (in litt.) states that Upper Guinea endemics tend to be mostly (but not all) contained in the forest block to the west of the Dahomey Gap. Some refer to these as the 'Upper Guinea Forest Endemics'. Even so a few of these birds trickle through the patches of forest in Togo and Benin to finally come to an end west of the Cameroon mountains. This natural barrier is perhaps the real delimiting factor as to where 'WEST' Africa ends and 'CENTRAL' Africa begins.

Upper Guinea (forest) Endemic species (Nik Borrow in litt.); * not yet recorded in Ghana

Each of us had birded various African countries before and therefore had his own personal wish-list of other species. Our trip was organized by Ashanti African Tours (info@ashantiafricantours.com) led by Mark Williams. Ashanti did a perfect job and we were very satisfied with their work: logistics ok, very good guides: sharp, strict, helpful and with sufficient perseverance, safe driver, accommodation on average fair, good food and a productive itinerary (though 4110 km's). It would perhaps have been better if we had left our hotels a bit earlier on most days to be able to start bird watching at first light. In the south, in the belt with fragments of Upper Guinea rainforest, we visited Kakum, Ankasa, Bobiri and Bonkro (for the Picathartes) and Shai Hills in the south east. In the north, in a more savannah like landscape, we visited Mole NP, Tongo Hills, Tono Dam and the White Volta river near Bawku (for the Egyptian Plover). We recorded 24 of the 44 Upper Guinea endemic species of Borrow's modern list of endemics extending to the Dahomey Gap and extending to South-West Cameroon combined of which 10 have not yet been recorded in Ghana. We ended with a list of 426 species of which 12 were heard only (Great Blue Turaco, Western Bronze-naped Pigeon, Olive Long-tailed Cuckoo, African Scops Owl, Northern White-faced Owl, African Barred Owlet, Brown Nightjar, Yellow-billed Barbet, Sabine's Puffback, Sooty Boubou, White-tailed Ant Thrush and Snowycrowned Robin-Chat). Mammals are not very abundant in Ghana, we recorded 18 species (of which Demidoff's Galago was heard only), mainly in Mole National Park. We simply had a great trip!

The top 7 birds seen in Ghana

- 1. Yellow-headed Picathartes (by far the most popular bird of the trip!)
- 2. Egyptian Plover
- 3. Long-tailed Hawk
- 4. Congo Serpent-Eagle
- 5. Thick-billed Cuckoo
- 6. Dwarf Bittern
- 7. Green Twinspot

Best species of the trip: Hartlaub's Duck, Dwarf Bittern, Congo Serpent-Eagle, Red-thighed Sparrowhawk, Long-tailed Hawk, Fox Kestrel, Forest and Whitethroated Francolin, Egyptian Plover, African Collared-Dove, Blue-headed Wood Dove, Grey Parrot, Yellow-billed and Guinea Turaco, Thick-billed, Olive Longtailed and Yellow-throated Cuckoo, Fraser's and Akun Eagle-Owl, Black, Mottled, Cassins and Sabine's Spinetail, White-bellied Kingfisher, Black, Blue-headed and Rosy Bee-eater, Black Dwarf, Piping, Brown-cheeked, Black-casqued and Yellowcasqued Hornbill, Naked-faced, Bristle-nosed and Hairy-breasted Barbet, Wilcock's and Cassin's Honeyquide, African Piculet, Little Green, Melancholy and Fire-bellied Woodpecker, Rufous-sided Broadbill, Blue-headed Crested-Flycatcher, White-breasted, Blue and Purple-throated Cuckoo-shrike, Chestnutbellied Helmetshrike, African and Black-and-white Shrike-flycatcher, West African Batis, Red-cheeked Wattle-eye, Finch's Flycatcher-Thrush, White-tailed Ant Thrush, White-tailed Atlethe, Narrow-tailed Starling, Copper-tailed Glossy-Starling, Ussher's, Little Grey, Dusky Blue and Tessmann's Flycatcher, Western Forest Robin, Blue-shouldered Robin-Chat, White-throated Blue-Swallow, Preuss' Swallow, Fanti Sawwing, Green-tailed and Grey-headed Bristlebill, Western Bearded and Yellow-bearded Greenbul, Rock-loving and Rufous Cisticola, Blackcapped and Sharpe's Apalis, Kemp's Longbill, Yellow-bellied Hyliota, Puvel's, Pale-breasted and Brown Illadopsis, Blackcap and Brown Babbler, Yellow-headed Picathartes, Forest Penduline-Tit, Tit-hylia, Grey-headed, Chestnut-breasted and White-breasted Negrofinch, Green-backed Twinspot, Black-bellied Seedcracker, Western Bluebill, Black-faced Firefinch, Wilson's Indigobird, Orange, Vieillot's Black, Maxwell's Black, Preuss' and Compact Weaver, Blue-billed, Crested, Redvented and Red-headed Malimbe, Reichenbach's, Buff-throated, Tiny, Fraser's and Johanna's Sunbird and Brown-rumped Bunting.

Hoped for but not seen were: Freckled Nightjar, White-breasted Guineafowl, African Finfoot, Spot-breasted Ibis, White-crested Bittern, Forbes's Plover, Beaudouin's Snake Eagle, Pel's Fishing-Owl, Spotted Creeper, Rufous-winged Illadopsis and Jameson's Antpecker.

Friday	22 April	Left Amsterdam by plane (flight KL 589) and arrived in Accra at 21.30 hrs. Slept in Hotel Alexis off the Tema Akosombo road not far from the international airport of Accra (info@alexishotelgh.com).

Saturday	23 April	By minivan to the Shai Hills in the morning and to the Sakumono Lagoon and Winneba Plains in the afternoon. Slept in the Rainforest Lodge in Cape Coast (www.rainforestlodgegh.com).
Sunday	24 April	By minivan to the Antwikuaa Forest and the river Pra in the morning and the Ebekawopa Rain Forest in the afternoon. Slept in the Rainforest Lodge in Cape Coast.
Monday	25 April	By minivan to the Ebekawopa Rain Forest in the morning and to Kakum NP in the afternoon, walked the Canopy Walk there in the afternoon and owled there and in Abrafo in the evening. Slept in the Rainforest Lodge in Cape Coast.
Tuesday	26 April	By minivan to Kakum NP (Canopy Walkagain) and Abrafo again in the morning and to the Ensuta Forest in the afternoon. Slept in the Shama Guesthouse in Shama.
Wednesday	27 April	By minivan to the Ensuta Forest in the morning and by minivan and Landrover to Ankasa in the afternoon. Slept in the Gracia Hotel in Halfassini (hotelgracia@gmail.com).
Thursday	28 April	By minivan and Landrover to Ankasa in the morning, birded en route near Kikam and Brenu Beach. Slept in the Rainforest Lodge in Cape Coast.
Friday	29 April	By minivan to the Aboabo Forest in the morning and to Bonkro in the afternoon, on foot to the Picathartes rock there. Slept in the Rexmar Hotel in Kumasi (www.rexmar.com).
Saturday	30 April	By minivan from Kumasi to Mole NP with stops at Tanoso and along the entrance road to Mole NP. Slept in the Mole Motel. (motel.mole@yahoo.com).
Sunday	1 May	By minivan and on foot through the forest along the Samole Loop not far from the motel, including the hide near the lake in the morning and the Burugbani Loop in the afternoon. Slept in the Mole Motel.
Monday	2 May	By minivan to the river Mognori and later the Samole Loop in the morning and the Burugbani Loop in the afternoon. Slept in the Motel Mole.
Tuesday	3 May	By minivan to the airstrip of Mole NP in the early morning and mainly on the highway to Bolgatanga the rest of the day with stops at the White Volta pond and a detour to Tongo Hills in the afternoon. Slept in the Sira Lodge in Bolgatanga (siralodge@yahoo.com).
Wednesday	4 May	By minivan to the Tono Dam near Navrongo in the morning and to the White Volta river near Bawku in the afternoon. Slept in the Sira Lodge in Bolgatanga.
Thursday	5 May	By minivan from Bolgatanga to Kumasi with a detour to Tongo Hills and stops near Disiga. Slept in the Silicon Hotel (www.siliconhotel.com).



Saturday	7 May	By minivan to the Atewa Range and walked to the summit in the morning, drove to Accra in the afternoon to take flight KL 580 to Amsterdam. Slept in the plane.
Sunday	8 May	Arrived in Amsterdam at 6.15 hrs. Slept at home.

Daily log

22 April

Left Amsterdam around 15.00 hrs. for the 6,5 hour KL 589 flight to Accra. Met our guides William Apraku (aprakuw@yahoo.com) and Paul Mensah (paul4me51@yahoo.com) and our driver Michel and drove in our air-conditioned minivan to the Alexis Hotel about thirty minutes from the Kotoka International Airport of Accra off the Tema Akosombo road, where we arrived at 22.00 hrs. (2 hours time difference with Holland, earlier). Loud live music didn't allow much sleeping before 24.00 hrs. No bird watching activities.

23 April

Birded the **Shai Hills** from 6.00 to 11.00 hrs. Noteworthy species were: African Cuckoo-Hawk, Greater Honeyguide, Green-headed and Splendid Sunbird, Violet Turaco and distant views of Rosy Bee-eater. Birded the **Sakumono Lagoon** along the coastal road from 13.00 to 14.00 hrs., where we found among others Greater Painted Snipe and Collared Pratincole and drove further west to Cape Coast with a short stop at the Winneba Plains (no bustards) to arrive at the Rainforest Lodge, not far from the **Kakum NP**, at 19.15 hrs. The weather was fine: dry and very hot with temperatures between 32 and 37 degrees, some clouds: the standard for the whole trip. The Rainforest Lodge turned out to be one of the best places where we stayed in Ghana.

24 April

Birded the **Antwikuaa Forest** by walking the road between 7.30 and 9.30 hrs. when bird activity is at its peak with Congo Serpent-Eagle as the star bird. Drove to the **river Pra** with among others the highly appreciated White-throated Blue Swallow as well as Brown Sunbird, Mottled Spinetail and very good views of Ethiopian Swallows. Drove to the forest beyond **Ebekawopa** after our lunch break - when we birded the area in front of our hotel - and birded a forest near a cultivated area and an undisturbed part of the forest from 16.00 to 20.00 hrs. which produced Copper-tailed Starling and a courting Rufous-sided Broadbill. The owling didn't work this evening. Slept in the Rainforest Lodge again.

25 April

Drove again to the forest beyond **Ebekawopa** and birded both secondary and primary forest. The primary forest was very rewarding with Red-billed Dwarf Hornbill, Grey-headed Bristlebill, Western Bearded Greenbul and Melancholy Woodpecker, after having found the very attractive Buff-throated Sunbird in the secondary forest. We did the Canopy Walk in Kakum NP in the afternoon after a walk on a trail through good forest (Forest Partridge and a 15 cm long black scorpion) and had only distant views of the must see Browncheeked, Yellow-casqued and Blackcasqued Hornbills. Did some owling again till 19.30 hrs., initially without success in Kakum, eventually with very good views of Fraser's Eagle-Owl beyond the village of **Abrafo.** Slept in the Rain Forest Lodge again.

26 April

Were back at the **Canopy Walk in Kakum NP** at first light and birded there from 5.45 to 9.30 hrs. which produced Square-tailed Sawwing, Yellow-billed Turaco and Sharpe's Apalis. Drove further west again, had lunch and checked in at the Shama Guesthouse in Shama and drove in a 4W drive Landrover to be able to pass the muddiest parts of some dirt roads to the **Ensuta Forest** where we birded from 16.00 to 19.30 hrs. with two Akun's Eagle-Owls and Ussher's Flycatchers as highlights. Slept in the just a bit better than basic Shama Guesthouse (shower not working).

27 April

Drove again to the **Ensuta Forest** and birded along the road from 7.00 to 10.30 hrs. This morning the birding was rather slow, nevertheless with White-tailed Alethe and Brown Illadopsis. Drove to Halfassini and checked in at the rather basic Gracia Hotel. Drove to **Ankasa Reserve** in the afternoon (16.00 to 19.00 hrs.) and went in the Landrover from the visitors center over muddy dirt roads to the area of the ponds, where we found the much sought after Hartlaub's Duck and Dwarf Bittern. For the first time we had a few drops of rain. Slept in the Gracia Hotel in Halfassini (shower not working).

28 April

Birded in **Ankasa Reserve** again with the Landrover from 6.00 to 12.30 hrs. again with good views of Dwarf Bittern (first pond) and Hartlaub's Duck (two on a tree in the third pond). Found a feeding flock with among others African Piculet, Yellow-bearded Greenbul and Forest Penduline Tit. Drove east, had lunch at Takoradi and went back to the Rainforest Lodge in Cape Coast with stops at a pond with Little Grebes and at the Amazuli River near Kikam with Reichenbach's Sunbird and Giant Kingfisher. Slept in the Rainforest Lodge again.

29 April

Drove to the **Aboabo Forest** and birded there from 7.00 to 10.00 hrs. with Blue Cuckoo-shrike, African Piculet (prolonged views of two preening birds!), West African Batis, Levaillant Cuckoo, Tessmann's Flycatcher and Lemon-bellied Crombec as highlights. Drove to the north to the village of **Bonkro** and started our Picathartes excursion: the walk of about 60 minutes with the rare Yellow-throated Cuckoo on the way!, the climb to the rock of the Picathartes, the waiting on this rock from 14.30 to 16.24 hrs., the 30 minutes watching and photographing the 5 Yellow-headed Picathartes flying around, the walk back at 17.00 hrs. and the walking around in the village. Unquestionably the highlight of our trip! Drove on to Kumasi to check in at the Rexmar Hotel.

30 April

Today a long drive from **Kumasi to Mole National Park** in the north of Ghana. Left Kumasi at 7.00 hrs., had lunch at Tamale and arrived in Mole NP at 19.00 hrs. Walked near Tanoso from 9.00 to 10.30 hrs. which produced Yellow-bellied Hyliota and Red-winged Warbler. Also walked in the roadside forest 45 minutes from Mole NP and found Bruce's Green Pigeon, Stone Partridge, Brown-backed Woodpecker and Brown-rumped Bunting. Slept in the Mole Motel, provided with all the conveniences we needed and good views from the dining room as a bonus. Yet we had to wash ourselves with buckets of water again, as the showers were not working.

1 May

Birded the forest near the motel at the **Samole Loop** (no Pel's Fishing-Owl) from 6.30 to 12.00 hrs., had a lunch break from 12.00 to 15.30 hrs. and birded the **Burugbani Loop** from 15.30 to 19.45 hrs. The morning with Black-faced Firefinch, Oriole Warbler, White-throated Francolin and Streaky-headed Seedeater as usual being more productive than the afternoon with Sun Lark and White-breasted Cuckoo-shrike as well as a Greyish Eagle-Owl near the dining room after sunset. Slept in the Mole Motel again.

2 May

Birded the riverine forest near the **Mognori River** with Thick-billed Cuckoo and Red-headed Lovebird from 6.30 to 8.00 hrs. and the **Samole Loop** (where Pel's Fishing-Owl was again not to be found) from 8.15 to 9.30 hrs. and spent some time near the hide at the lake to watch the African Elephants. Had a lunch break from 12.00 to 15.30 hrs. and did the **Burugbani Loop** again (African Golden Oriole and Black Cuckoo) to search for Forbes' Plover (in vain again) on the gravel plain. Heard Northern White-faced Owl at the **air-strip**. Slept in the Mole Motel again.

3 May

Birded the **air-strip** again from 6.00 to 7.30 hrs. where we had good views of White-throated Francolin and Rufous Cisticola. Left Mole NP at 8.10 hrs. for the long drive to Bolgatanga. Had a break at the **White Volta pond** which yielded African Pygmy Goose as well as Squacco and Purple Heron. Drove to the **Tongo Hills just east of Bolgatanga** and birded there from 16.30 to 18.00 hrs. to find Fox Kestrel, Chestnut-bellied Starling (glimpses), Rock-loving Cisticola (heard) and Dark Chanting Goshawk. Drove back to Bolgatanga to check in at the fairly comfortable Sira Lodge.

4 May

Drove north to the **Tono Dam beyond the village of Navrongo** about 4 km from the border with Burkina Faso and walked the fields below the dam from 6.30 to 11.30 hrs. Found the African Collared Dove which is rare in Ghana as well as plenty of Chestnut-bellied Starlings (plenty), Four-banded Sandgrouse, one Bronze-tailed Starling and the unexpected Jacobin Cuckoo. Had a lunch break from 12.30 to 15.00 hrs. Drove to the **White Volta river beyond the village of Bawku** and at the sandy beaches of this river found the much sought after Egyptian Plover, also had Yellow-billed Oxpecker and White-billed Buffalo-Weaver in this area. Slept in the Sira Lodge again.

5 May

Left Bolgatanga at 6.45 hrs. for the long way back to Kumasi. Birded the **Tongo Hills** again from 7.15 to 8.00 hrs., where we found Rock-loving Cisticola (very good views this time), Bush Petronia, African Silverbill and Fox Kestrel (giving a show). Continued our drive to Kumasi and stopped 5 km north of **the village of Disiga at a lake near a bridge** which produced the beautiful Zebra Waxbill, Black-rumped Waxbill and African Quailfinch. Arrived in Kumasi at 18.00 hrs. and checked in at the comfortable Silicon Hotel. In the garden we had a very out of range African Silverbill.

6 May

Drove to the **Bobiri Forest & Butterfly Sanctuary** and birded there from 6.15 to 10.45 hrs. with goodies as Black Dwarf Hornbill, Long-tailed Hawk (finally and very good views), Little Green Woodpecker and Little Grey Flycatcher. Drove to the Royal Bleumich Hotel between Tafo and Kukurantumi and checked in. Drove to the lower part of the Atewa Range and birded that area from 16.00 to 18.15 hrs. to find Red-cheeked Wattle-eye, Magpie Manakin, African Hobby and Blackand-white Flycatcher. Slept in the fairly comfortable Royal Bleumich Hotel.

7 May

Left our hotel early to walk to the **summit of Atewa Range** from 5.40 to 12.15 hrs. with goodies as Puvel's Illadopsis, White-spotted Flufftail (finally good views for all of us), Kemp's Longbill (at last seen very well), Grey-throated Tit-Flycatcher, African Forest-Flycatcher, Blue-headed Bee-eater (nearly on the highest point) and Preuss' Weaver (on the very summit) as a reward. Took a shower and packed our luggage and left the Royal Bleumich Hotel at 15.00 hrs., stopped a few minutes on the way to the airport at a **roadside pond** where Allen's Gallinule didn't show up unfortunately. Left Accra at 22.00 hrs. with flight KL 580. Slept in the plane.

8 Mav

Landed at Schiphol, Amsterdam at 6.15 hrs, said goodbye to each other and went home to join our families.

Weather

The weather was beautiful every day, though rather hot with temperatures frequently over 35 degrees Celsius. On two occasions we had a few drops of rain but this is hardly worth mentioning.

Annoyances

Ghana is a pleasant and safe country. We did take malaria prophylaxis (Malarone), but we didn't see too many mosquitoes. One of us was bitten by a tick once. Ants were a bigger problem on some occasions. Some of us had stomach problems most likely because of bad food (fish?). Between 10.00 and 15.00 hrs. it is simply too hot for birding: you'd better stay in your airconditioned room then, while most of the birds will be hiding in the shade anyway. Travelling from the south to the very north of Ghana and from the east to the west often on dirt roads or highways with many pot holes means a long time in the car, which might get boring in the long run. Obtaining a visa for Ghana at the embassy in The Hague was a time consuming and not very pleasant activity.

7. Western Reef-Egret (Egretta gularis)

10 seen at the Sakumono Lagoon on 23-4 and 1 at Brenu Beach on 28-4.

8. Intermediate Egret (Mesophoyx intermedia)

10 seen at the Sakumono Lagoon on 23-4 and 1 at Mole NP on 3-5.

9. Grey Heron (Ardea cinerea)

2 seen at Amazuli river near Kikam on 28-4, 1 at Mole NP on 2-5 and 1 at the White Volta pond on 3-5.

10. Black-headed Heron (Ardea melanocephala)

1 seen just outside Mole NP and 1 at the White Volta pond on 3-5.

11. Purple Heron (Ardea purpurea)

2 seen at the White Volta pond on 3-5, 2 at the Tono Dam on 4-5 and 1 at a lake north of Disiga on 5-5.

12. Great Egret (Casmerodius albus)

8 seen at the Sakumono Lagoon on 23-4, 1 at the river Pra on 24-4 and 1 at Amazuli river near Kikam on 28-4.

13. Cattle Egret (Bubulcus ibis)

Common, seen daily.

14. Squacco Heron (Ardeola ralloides) 6 at the White Volta pond on 3-5.

15. Striated Heron (Butorides striatus)

2 seen at the Sakumono Lagoon on 23-4, 2 at Mole NP on 1-5, 2 there on 2-5 and 1 on 3-5 and 1 at the Tono Dam and 1 at the White Volta river near Bawku on 4-5.

16. Black-crowned Night-Heron (Nycticorax nycticorax)

1 seen at Mole NP on 1-5 and 2 there on 2-5.

17. Dwarf Bittern (*Ixobrychus sturmii*)

A very illusive bird that took us a long time before seeing it walking very slowly through the vegetation at the first pond at Ankasa on 27-4 and again on 28-4.

21. Marabou Stork (Leptoptilos crumeniferus)

4 seen at Mole NP on 1-5.

22. African Cuckoo-Falcon (Aviceda cuculoides)

2 seen very well at the Shai Hills on 23-4, 2 at Mole NP on 2-5 and 2 at Bbiri Forest on 6 -5.

23. European Honey-buzzard (*Pernis apivorus*)

1 seen at Antwikwuaa on 24-4 and 1 at the Tono Dam on 4-5.

24. Black-shouldered Kite (Elanus caeruleus)

1 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4, 10 at the Sakumono Lagoon and en route to Cape Coast on 23-4, 1 at Antwikwuaa on 24-4 and 1 at the Tono Dam on 4-4.

25. Black Kite (Milvus migrans)

1 seen at the Tono Dam on 4-4

26. Yellow-billed Kite (Milvus parasiticus)

Common, seen daily.

4 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4, 2 en route to Cape Coast on 23-4, 1 at Brenu Beach on 28-4, 1 en route from Kamasi to Mole NP on 30-4, 4 at Mole NP on 1-5 and 1 there on 2-5 and 3 at the Tono Dam and 1 en route to the White Volta river near Bawku on 4-5.

38. Red-thighed Sparrowhawk (Accipiter erythropus)

1 seen mobbed by all kind of songbirds at the Kakum Canopy Walk on 26-4.

39. Black Goshawk (Accipiter melanoleucus)

1 seen at Abrafo on 26-4.

40. Long-tailed Hawk (Urotriorchis macrourus)

1 heard at Ensuta Forest on 27-4 and prolonged views (one of the nicest records of a raptor) of 1 bird in the canopy mobbed by Velvet-mantled Drongos at Bobiri Forest on 6-5.

41. Grasshopper Buzzard (Butastur rufipennis)

1 seen en route from Kumasi to Mole NP on 30-4, 1 at Mole NP on 1-5, 3 en route from Mole NP to Bolgatanga on 3-5, 1 at the Tono Dam and 1 en route to the White Volta river near Bawku on 4-5.

45. Ayres's Hawk Eagle (Hieraaetus ayresii)

1 seen less than 5 minutes after the Congo Serpent-Eagle at Antwikwuaa on 24-5.

46. Eurasian Kestrel (Falco tinnunculus)

10 seen en route to Cape Coast on 23-4 and 1 en route on 25-4.

47. Fox Kestrel (Falco alopex)

1 seen at the Tongo Hills on 3-5 and great overhead views of 2 there on 5-5.

3 seen at Mole NP on 1-5, 3 there on 2-5 and 2 on 3-5. Twice we had great views of a bird responding to the tape.

56. Double-spurred Francolin (Francolinus bicalcaratus)

2 seen at the Winneba Plains on 23-4, 8 near Mole NP on 30-4, 15 at Mole NP on 1-5, 3 there on 2-5 and 8 on 3-5, 6 at the Tono Dam and 5 en route to the White Volta river near Bawku on 4-5.

1 seen at the river Pra on 24-4, 1 at Abrafo on 26-4, 1 at Ensuta Forest on 26-4, 2 at Ankasa on 27-4 and 1 there on 28-4, 1 at Amazuli river near Kikam on 28-4, 4 at Mole NP on 1-5 and 5 there on 2-5, 5 at a lake north of Disiga on 5-5 and 1 at a pond en route to Accra on 7-5.

63. Greater Painted-snipe (Rostratula benghalensis)

3 seen at the Sakumono Lagoon on 23-4, 1 at the White Volta Pond on 3-5 and 1 at a lake north of Disiga on 5-5.

Common, seen almost daily. Not seen on 4, 5 and 6-5.

98. Grey Parrot (*Psittacus erithacus*)

2 seen at Antwikwuaa on 24-4, 6 at Kakum Canopy Walk on 26-4 and 3 at Bobiri Forest on 6-5.

99. Red-fronted Parrot (Poicephalus gulielmi)

10 seen at Antwikwuaa on 24-4, 7 at the Kakum Canopy Walk on 25-4 and 10 there on 26-4, 2 at Ensuta Forest on 27-4 and 2 at Bonkro on 29-4.

100. Senegal Parrot (Poicephalus senegalus)

12 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4, 9 at Mole NP on 1-5, 25 there on 2-5 and 2 on 3-5.

101. Red-headed Lovebird (Agapornis pullarius)

1 seen at Hotel Alexis and very good views of 10 at the Mognori river, Mole NP on 2-5.

8 seen at the Shai hills on 23-4, 2 near Tonoso, en route from Kumasi to Mole NP on 30-4, 2 at Mole NP on 1-5, 5 there on 2-5 and 1 on 3-5 and 1 at the Tono Dam on 4-5.

106. Western Grey Plantain-eater (*Crinifer piscator*)

6 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4, 10 en route to Cape Coast on 23-4, 2 en route on 24-4, 2 at Ensuta Forest on 27-4, 3 at Brenu Beach on 28-4, 2 en route from Kumasi to Mole NP on 30-4, 10 at Mole NP on 1-5, 5 there on 2-5 and 6 on 3-5 and 6 at the Tono dam and 2 en route to the White Volta river near Bawku on 4-5.

107. Great Blue Turaco (*Corythaeola cristata*)

1 heard at Ankasa on 28-4. (Only heard by DB, PL, DM & PS).

108. Jacobin Cuckoo (Oxylophus jacobinus)

1 seen very well at the Tono Dam on 4-5. This was a lifer for one of the guides.

109. Levaillant's Cuckoo (Oxylophus levaillantii)

1 seen at Aboabo Forest on 29-4.

110. Great Spotted Cuckoo (Clamator glandarius) 1 heard at the Tono Dam on 4-5 and 2 seen verv

well at the lower part of the Atewa Range on 6-5.

113. Black Cuckoo (Cuculus clamosus)

1 heard at Mole NP on 1-5 and 1 posted bird seen there on 2-5.

114. African Cuckoo (Cuculus gularis)

1 heard at the Winneba Plains on 23-4 and 1 seen at the Mognori river, Mole NP on 2-5.

115. Olive Long-tailed Cuckoo (Cercococcyx olivinus)

1 heard at Bobiri on 6-5. (Only heard by DB, PL & DM).

116. Yellow-throated Cuckoo (Chrysococcyx flavigularis)

Great views of 1 at Bonkro on 29-4. This bird responded very well to the tape.

117. Klaas's Cuckoo (Chrysococcyx klaas)

1 heard at Ebekawopa Rain Forest on 25-4, 1 seen at Ankasa on 27-4, 2 at the Tongo Hills on 3-5, 1 at the Tono Dam on 4-5 and 1 heard at the Atewa Range on 7-5.





1 heard at Ebekawopa Rain Forest on 25-4 and 1 eventually seen fairly well by all of us at the lower part of the Atewa Range on 6-5. This bird gave some of us nightmares because it stayed only 1-2 seconds at the same location.

241. Finsch's Flycatcher-Thrush (Neocossyphus finschii) UG(F)E

1 heard at Ebekawopa Rain Forest on 24-4 and good views of 1 at Bobiri Forest on 6-5.

242. White-tailed Ant Thrush (*Neocossyphus poensis*)

1 heard at the Kakum Canopy Walk on 26-4, 1 at Ankasa on 28-4, 1 at Aboabo Forest on 29-4 and 1 seen briefly at the higher part of the Atewa Range on 7-5.

243. African Thrush (*Turdus pelios*)

1 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4, 1 near the river Pra on 24-4 and 1 at Ebekawopa Rain Forest on 25-4, 2 en route from Kusami to Mole NP on 30-4, 2 at Tamale on 3-5, 1 at the Tono Dam on 4-5 and 1 at Bobiri Forest on on 6-5.

244. White-tailed Alethe (Pseudalethe diademata) **UG(F)E**

1 heard at Ebekawopa Rain Forest on 25-4, 1 seen fairly well at Ensuta Forest and 1 heard at the higher part of the Atewa Range on 7-5.

245. Narrow-tailed Starling (Poeoptera lugubris)

20 seen at Antwikwuaa on 24-4.

246. Chestnut-winged Starling (Onychognathus fulgidus)

12 seen at Antwikwuaa on 24-4.

247. Copper-tailed Glossy-Starling (Lamprotornis cupreocauda) UG(F)E

1 seen and 1 heard at Antwikwuaa on 24-4, 2 seen at Ebekawopa Rain Forest on 25-4, 2 at the Kakum Canopy Walk on 26-4, 2 at Ankasa on 27-4 and 2 there on 28-4 and 1 heard at the higher part of the Atewa Range on 7-5.

248. Purple Glossy-Starling (*Lamprotornis purpureus*)

8 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4, 3 en route from Kusami to Mole NP on 30-4, 1 at Mole NP on 1-5, 1 en route from Mole NP to Bolgatanga on 3-5 and 20 at the Tono Dam on 4-5.

249. Bronze-tailed Glossy-Starling (Lamprotornis chalcurus)

Poor views of 1 at the Tono Dam on 4-5. (Only seen by DB, PL, DM & PS).

250. Greater Blue-eared Glossy-Starling (Lamprotornis chalybaeus)

6 seen at Mole NP on 1-5, 1 there on 2-5 and 2 on 3-5 and 1 at the Tono Dam on 4-5.

251. Lesser Blue-eared Glossy-Starling (Lamprotornis chloropterus) 1 seen briefly at the Tono Dam on 4-5. (Only seen by PS).

252. Splendid Starling (*Lamprotornis splendidus*)

3 seen at Antwikwuaa on 24-4, 2 at Ensuta Forest on 27-4, 1 at Ankasa on 28-4, 6 at Aboabo Forest on 29-4 and 3 at Bobiri Forest on 6-5.

253. Long-tailed Glossy-Starling (Lamprotornis caudatus)

3 seen at Mole NP on 1-5, 6 there on 2-5 and 1 on 3-5, 30 at the Tono Dam on 4-5 and 30 at the White Volta river near Bawku on 4-5.

254. Chestnut-bellied Starling (Lamprotornis pulcher)

1 seen briefly at the Tongo Hills on 3-5, 20 at the Tono Dam on 4-5 and 1 en route to the White Volta river near Bawku on 4-5.

271. Snowy-crowned Robin-Chat (Cossypha niveicapilla)

1 heard at Mole NP on 1-5. (Only heard by PL & DM).

272. White-crowned Robin-Chat (Cossypha albicapilla)

1 seen at Alexis Hotel on 23-4 and 1 at the Mognori river on 2-5. (Only seen by DB, PL & DM).

273. Whinchat (Saxicola rubetra)

1 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4.

2 seen very well at Mole NP on 1-5, 2 there on 2-5 and 1 at 3-5.

275. Mocking Cliff-Chat (Thamnolaea cinnamomeiventris)

3 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4.

276. Rock Martin (Ptyonoprogne *fuligula*)

3 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4 and 10 at the Tongo Hills on 3-5.

277. Barn Swallow (Hirundo rustica)

2 seen at the river Pra on 24-4, 2 at Brenu Beach on 28-4, 2 at Bonkro on 29-4 and 1 at the White Volta river near Bawku on 4-5.

278. Red-chested Swallow (Hirundo lucida)

2 seen at Mole NP on 1-5 and 1 at the White Volta pond on 3-5.

279. Ethiopian Swallow (Hirundo aethiopica)

Very good views of 40 seen at the river Pra on 24-4 and 2 at Ebekawopa Rain Forest on 25-4.





358. Grey-headed Negrofinch (*Nigrita canicapilla*)

361. Western Bluebill (Spermophaga hematina)

1 male seen very well at Aboabo Forest on 29-4 and 1 male at the higher part of the Atewa range on 7-5.

362. Bar-breasted Firefinch (*Lagonosticta rufopicta*)

6 seen at the Shai Hills on 23-4, 4 at the Winneba Plains on 23-4, 5 at Antwikwuaa on 24-4, 4 at Ebekawopa Rain forest on 25-4, 2 at Brenu Beach on 28-4, 2 at Mole NP on 1-5 and 3 there on 2-5, 3 at the Tongo Hills on 3-5, 10 at the Tongo Dam on 4-5 and 2 at Bobiri Forest on 6-5.

367. Lavender Waxbill (Estrilda caerulescens)




